



NON-PROFIT STUDENT BOARD MEMBER OPPORTUNITY

The Friends of the Folsom Parkways (FOFP) is an advocacy community-based nonprofit organization founded over 30 years ago to promote trails (bike and walking trails) in Folsom, examining development projects for trail connections, and advocating for preservation of oaks and natural areas in Folsom. The FOFP website is <https://www.friendsoffolsomparkways.org/> and can also be found on Facebook. FOFP coordinates trails and nature area projects to benefit the community. Our meetings frequently have elected officials and commissioners, as well as City staff and other non-profit representatives. FOFP continues to increase its community presence.

2023 was the first year of our Youth Director positions. We had two Seniors from Folsom High School who gained valuable experience in a non-profit, including speaking before the Folsom City Council. Our Bylaws permit up to three Youth Director members on our Board of Directors. These are VOTING positions for special young people who would like to be involved in an important organization and represent and advocate the young person's perspective. The Youth description:

Youth Director(s) – A minimum one, no more than three from Folsom-area high schools. May interact with and/or support one or more of the director positions or committees to help advance/achieve various objectives.

What is FOFP looking for?

Character Traits - Enthusiastic, innovative, reliable, a zest for knowledge and a desire to make a difference in his/her community and a commitment for the 2024-25 School year. Applicants are preferred to be Juniors or Seniors in the 24-25 school year. Juniors would have an opportunity to continue for a second year based on interest and performance. We are looking for young people who might have an interest in a further education or perhaps even a career in advocacy, nonprofits, parks and recreation or outdoors pursuits. Commitment – The minimum commitment is one board meeting a Month (Second Tuesday from 6:30-8:30 pm in Folsom) (Attendance is MANDATORY), participation in at least one committee, participation in at least two FOFP events (Trails projects, clean up days, organized bike rides, etc.).

What are the benefits to Board membership?

Membership in the FOFP, engage in a nonprofit board of directors, learn, organize and participate in community projects, meet and engage with civic leaders, and build your college or job resume.
